The Richfield Planning Board held a monthly meeting on September 9, 2019. The meeting was called to order by Chairman Dan Sullivan at 7:02 pm.

David M. Diaz, Land Protection Manager with Otsego Land Trust gave a presentation in regards to a NYS Farmland Protection Grant for the Cantwell farm. Otsego County Land Trust is looking to use the grant money to preserve approximately 700 acres of Woodlawn Dairy Farm, owned by Tim and Susan Cantwell. Diaz gave a presentation on how the program works and answered questions the board had.

The board had a discussion on articles Sullivan had sent to the board in regards to solar installations and SEQR.

The clerk informed the board that all members must complete sexual harassment training by October 16. The clerk will email the board members the information to access the training.
